The secondary school program in Italy is available from September 2026 to June 2027 with a high school attendance from a min. of 3 month to 9 months maximum.

The deadline for September entry is 31st March 2026 and for January 2027 entry is 30th September 2026.

Early/Late applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Academic performance and regular school attendance are fundamental aspects that guarantee a good exchange program.

Age requirements and Italian level

The program is open to students aged 15-17.

We accept almost all levels of Italian speakers, but a minimum knowledge of Italian language is required (A2-B1)

Host-families

Host families are meticulously chosen by our dedicated network of local coordinators across Italy. To enrich the cultural exchange experience, we recommend applying for placements in smaller cities such as Turin, Perugia, or Venice, rather than major metropolitan areas like Rome, Milan, or Naples. **FAQ**

Schools and Education system

- Schools can either be public or private (in this case we will ask them the
 waive tuition fees or the student's family will be asked if he/she is prepared
 to pay the fees).
- Public schools are non religious, whereas private schools are very often Catholic.
- No uniforms are worn in Italian high schools. Schools can have an emphasis on languages, scientific studies, classical studies (including Latin and Greek) or technical skills. Exchange students are usually placed in the school year on the basis of their most recent school report but often attend some classes in other years depending on their Italian skills. The issuance of a transcript by the school can not be guaranteed. Should the student require credits for his/her school, it is his/her responsibility to ask the Italian school secretaries for school certificates.
- An arrival orientation covering program issues, cultural introduction to life in Italy and rules of the program will be held within the first weeks of arrival in the host community by the local coordinator. The local coordinator is ready to assist the student and the host family.





NON-EU STUDENTS

For non-EU citizens we must receive the complete dossier of the student at least 4 months before arrival because we have to forward it, together with the host family details and the school letter, to the Italian Ministry for Foreign Affairs. The official approval is normally issued no later than TWO months before the student arrives in Italy.

Experiment is on the list of the "authorized associations" for what concerns Visa issuing for non-EU students.

The Italian Ministry for Foreign Affairs is the only authority responsible for communicating the list of those allowed to obtain a Visa.

Not included within the Fees

- Insurance (which is the responsibility of the sending office*) a copy of the insurance policy must be sent to the office in Asti before students arrive in Italy, medicines
- Text books, stationery, specific school material, leisure time
- School enrollment fee when required (from 100€ to 300€ depending on the school)
- Cost of travel or holidays with host family (natural parental permission required)
- Cost for any health test required for travel, on arrival and on program
- Local transport, bus pass for school or travel for leisure activities
- Repatriation costs, additional flights or transfer if student leaves the program for any reason
- Flights or train travel to and from Italy
- Visa costs for entry to Italy if applicable

Payment instructions and Cancellation Fees

- Payments should be made upon receipt of an invoice, before student's arrival and transferred according to the instructions written on the invoice. Amounts must be paid in Euro (€).
- Cancellation fee: A minimum of Euro (€) 300,00 for cancellations any time after application papers are received by the Italian Office; 50% of the full fee if notified after host family and/or school placement has been communicated; 100% if notified less than 4 weeks in advance or after the program starts.
- Late fee: Euro (€) 150,00 if application is sent less than 8 weeks before arrival.


